ELECTION COMMISSION MEETING

Pursuant to Act 267 of the Public Acts of 1976 (Open Meetings Act) and MCL 168.540, 168.552 and 168.558, **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a meeting of the Flint Election Commission of the City of Flint will be held on Monday, April 27, 2026, at 10:00 a.m., in the Committee-of-the-Whole Room, City Council Chambers, 3rd Floor, Flint City Hall, 1101 S. Saginaw Street, Flint, Michigan.

The purpose of this meeting is to allow the City Clerk:

- I. To certify to the Election Commission the names of all candidates who have been qualified by the City Clerk for city offices (Office of the Mayor and Office of the City Council) for the August 4, 2026 Primary Election Ballot; and
- II. To certify to the Election Commission the names of all candidates who have been qualified by the City Clerk for the Office of City Council, and whose petitions have been properly filed, to be declared as nominees for offices in districts where no primary election will be held; and
- III. To make an official declaration regarding the insufficiency of petitions submitted by candidates for city offices, as well as other candidate disqualifications from the ballot.
