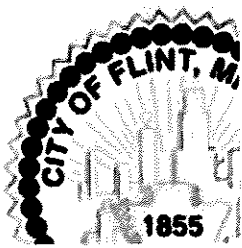

The City of Flint has used LaFontaine Automotive Group for multiple vehicle purchases throughout the years. They place a high value on the account they have for the City of Flint. Their MiDeal pricing is competitive, they offer us free delivery, and their customer service support is very responsive. We were notified there were 2026 PPV police units available and on hand. The City of Flint was offered 1<sup>st</sup> choice to purchase them. I requested the vehicles be put on hold pending a meeting with the finance department. We determined there were funds available and the replacements would be based on fully depreciated models still in service (pending replacement).

LaFontaine Automotive Group is a MiDeal participant. The City of Flint routinely utilizes MiDEAL to choose vendors. MiDEAL is the State of Michigan’s extended purchasing program, allowing eligible organizations like municipalities to buy goods and services using existing State of Michigan contracts at a reduced cost and without the need to process separate bids.

The police department division of vehicles was in desperate need of replacement. We received a grant that helped us procure (22) new vehicles in a single purchase which was a tremendous purchase. Now we can focus on vehicle capital planning and can pinpoint individual vehicles slotted for replacement. Based on our current reports there are (9) assets that are fully depreciated and over their useful life. We are in the financial position to be able to replace (5) of these vehicles for fiscal year 2026. Based on repair history, usage and mileages we have slotted 2403, 2707, 2713, 2709 and 2725 for replacement.

2701 - 2017 Chevrolet Tahoe

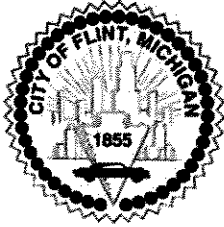

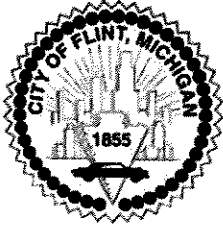

**WHEREAS**, the acceptance of this funding will support programs and services that improve the health, safety, and quality of life for senior residents of the City of Flint and throughout Genesee County; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to amend the FY2026 City of Flint Budget to recognize and appropriate the Senior Millage funds for the operation of the Eric Mays Senior and Community Service Center.

This agreement is a contract between the Genesee County Department of Senior Services and the City of Flint for the operation of the Eric Mays Senior and Community Service Center from January 1, 2026 through September 30, 2026. Under the contract, Genesee County will provide up to \$54,744 in Senior Millage funding (Level 1 funding) to support programs and services that improve the health, safety, and quality of life for county residents age 60 and older. The City of Flint agrees to operate the center in accordance with program requirements, including maintaining at least 40 hours of weekly operations and programming, providing educational and health-related activities, offering nutrition and transportation services, tracking participation, submitting monthly reimbursement requests with supporting documentation, and complying with financial, reporting, safety, and nondiscrimination standards.

The agreement also outlines rules for eligible expenditures, staff background checks and training, financial oversight, equipment ownership, audits, and program compliance, with the county retaining authority to withhold payments or terminate the contract if requirements are not met.

The funding supports educational, health, and social programming that helps older adults stay active, informed, and engaged in their community.

## 2. Improved health and wellness

Programs such as exercise classes, health screenings, wellness education, and nutrition services can help seniors maintain physical and mental health.

## 3. Access to meals and nutrition support

The center must provide congregate meal or nutrition programming, helping address food insecurity and promote healthy eating among seniors.

## 4. Transportation assistance

Transportation services to and from the center or for essential trips (such as grocery shopping or medical appointments) help seniors maintain independence.

## 5. Social connection and reduced isolation

Regular programming, events, and group activities give seniors opportunities to socialize, which can reduce loneliness and improve overall well-being.

## 6. Access to social services and resources

The center provides information, referrals, and assistance with programs such as housing resources, benefits enrollment, or health coverage.

## 7. Safe and consistent community space

The agreement requires the center to remain open at least 40 hours per week with a full-time director, ensuring residents have a reliable location for services and activities.

## 8. Local economic and community impact

The funding helps support staff positions, programming, and operations within the city while leveraging county millage funds to provide services that Flint might otherwise have to fund locally.

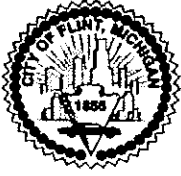

## Budget Highlights

**Total Award:** The contract provides up to \$54,744 in Senior Millage funding to the Eric Mays Senior and Community Service Center, operated by the City of Flint under the administration of the Genesee County Department of Senior Services.

**Funding Level:** The center is funded at Level 1, which corresponds to the minimum required monthly programming and service benchmarks for senior centers under the Senior Millage program.

**Reimbursement Structure:** Funds are reimbursed monthly, meaning the City must first incur eligible expenses and then submit documentation (invoices, payroll records, receipts, etc.) for reimbursement.

**Monthly Cap:** Reimbursement requests typically cannot exceed 1/9 of the total award per month (about \$6,083) unless prior approval is granted by the county.

**Eligible Expense Categories:** Budgeted expenditures generally fall into four categories:

**Administration:** salaries, fringe benefits, legal services

**Operations:** facility maintenance, insurance, utilities, office supplies

**Programming:** senior activities, events, and services

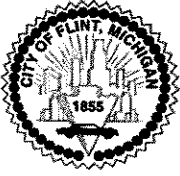
**Equipment:** computers, software, or other approved equipment purchases

These categories align with the budget and reimbursement forms attached to the contract.

**Deadline for Reimbursements:** All reimbursement receipts must be submitted no later than October 31, 2026 to be eligible for payment.

**In short:** The agreement provides \$54,744 in reimbursable funding from the Genesee County Senior Millage to support the operations, programming, and administration of the Eric Mays Senior and Community Service Center during the January–September 2026 program period

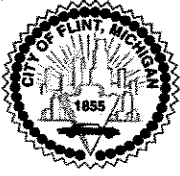

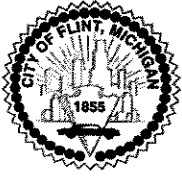
