CORRECTED Notice of 30-Day Public Comment Period & Public Hearing -

On April 5, 2022, the City of Flint published a Notice of 30-Day Public Comment Period & Public Hearing for its proposed 2022-23 Annual Action Plan. Within the notice, the HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (HOME) paragraph stated two different allocation amounts. The correct estimated HUD allocation is \$850,461.85. Also, all allocation amounts are estimated and will be proportionally increased or decreased once HUD publishes its actual allocations.

COMMENT PERIOD: The 30-day comment period for the City of Flint's 1-year Annual Action Plan began Wednesday, April 5, 2022. PUBLIC HEARING: The City of Flint held its public hearing on the proposed Annual Action Plan on Monday, April 18, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. in the City of Flint's Domed Auditorium, located at 1101 S. Saginaw Street. The hearing was held to provide for the opportunity for public comment on the City of Flint's proposed Annual Action Plan.

The public is advised that on or before Friday, May 13, 2022, Flint will submit to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) the 2022-23 Annual Action Plan. Prior to said submission, public comments are welcome on the proposed Annual Action Plan of the City of Flint in carrying out Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) program activities.

Current comments must be in writing and will be accepted at communitydevelopment@cityofflint.com, or in the Division of Community and Economic Development office, 1101 S. Saginaw, Rm S8. The comment period ends Monday, May 9, 2022. No changes are being made to the [recommendations](#) published on April 5, 2022.
