**RESOLUTION AMENDING THE EMPLOYMENT OF
RONALD BARBER AS WPC OPERATIONS ANALYST**

BY THE EMERGENCY MANAGER:

Pursuant to the authority granted the Emergency Manager by Public Act 436 of 2012, Ronald Barber has been employed by the City of Flint in the capacity of WPC Operations Analyst. Mr. Barber's employment with the City of Flint is at the will of the emergency Manager until such time as the Emergency Manager determines that his employment shall cease, or until such time as the Emergency Manager's authority terminates by operation of law; and


In order to provide continuity of services and related activities, the Department of Public Works has determined that it would be advantageous for the City to amend the resolution of which approved the employment of Ron Barber; and

Said amendment will set Mr. Barber's compensation in the not exceed amount of \$28.00 per hour for a maximum of 720 hours per calendar year of his employment; and

No other changes are authorized under this amendment, as it pertains to the employment of Ronald Barber as other condition remain as stated in resolution EME4312014.


IT IS RESOLVED, that the Emergency Manager does, on behalf of the City of Flint, authorize an amendment to resolution EME4312014, the employment of Ronald Barber under the terms and conditions stated above. Compensation shall continue be at the hourly rate of \$28.00, drawn from appropriated funds in line item 590-550.100-702.000, Wages and Salaries, with statutory taxes being withheld as required by law. The salary cap authorized by virtue of this resolution is \$20,160.00 per calendar year.


