Resolution Authorizing Change Order No. 6 to the Flint Fire Department Contract (12-158) Extending the Term until June 30, 2015

On June 26, 2012, the Emergency Manager adopted resolution no. 2012EM524 approving \$407,524 for the Flint Fire Department to purchase a fire truck and fire suppression equipment. An additional \$75,000 was allocated to the contract under Resolution No. 2013EM144, which was adopted June 26, 2013. Resolution No. EME3512014 extended the term of the contract until September 30, 2014. Resolution No. EME5612014 extended the term of the contract until January 31, 2015.

The fire truck has been delivered to the City. The vendor has already been paid. The balance of the contract funds will be used to acquire suppression equipment, which is currently being identified to be ordered. The department anticipates the order to be completed and equipment received and paid for by the end of June 30, 2015. Funds are available in the following accounts FCDBGPRIOR 274-748.160-977.500 expense, and FCDBGPRIOR 274-748.160-502.748 revenue.

IT IS RESOLVED, that the Emergency Manager authorizes appropriate City officials to do all things necessary to execute change order no. 6 to extend the term of the CDBG contract (12-158) with the Flint Fire Department until June 30, 2015. Funds for the contract are available in FCDBGPRIOR 274-748.160-977.500 expense, and FCDBGPRIOR 274-748.160-502.748 revenue.
