

Notification of Emergency Solutions Act – CARES Act Award

As a requirement of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) of 2020, the City of Flint, as a recipient of federal CARES Act funding for the Emergency Solutions (ESG-CV) program, must publish the use of such funding. Per CPD Notice 21-08:

The ESG-CV funds described in this Notice are not subject to the consultation and citizen participation requirements that otherwise apply to the Emergency Solutions Grants program, including the requirements under 24 CFR 91.100, 91.105, 91.110, and 91.115. However, as required by the CARES Act, each recipient must publish how it has used and will use its allocation, at a minimum, on the Internet at the appropriate government website or through other electronic media.

Sub awards of ESG-CV funding made by the City of Flint to local homeless shelters were published in the August 1, 2021 edition of the Flint Journal, and approved by the Flint City Council on August 10, 2021. These funds must be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus among individuals and families who are homeless or receiving homeless assistance and to support additional homeless assistance and homelessness prevention activities to mitigate the impacts created by the virus.

The City of Flint will award an additional \$50,000 in ESG-CV funds to My Brother's Keeper for reimbursement of funds previously expended on employee wages and salaries associated with the operation of the shelter.
