

# Love Your Block Resource Request Form

The City of Flint is offering resources to support neighborhood cleanups in 2019. Details on what is offered, who is eligible, and how to request resources are provided below.

## What resources are available?

#### **Dumpsters**

The City of Flint wants to provide dumpsters for residents and community groups, whose cleanup efforts are an essential part of blight elimination. Dumpsters will be delivered and removed on dates agreed on by the neighborhood group and City staff.

#### Support Crews

Crews are available to support your neighborhood cleanup, on a limited basis. Crews will assist with heavy work that residents and neighborhood groups are not able to do, including removing large fallen trees, clearing and chipping large and heavy debris, and removing heavy waste illegally dumped. Crews are available on a limited number of Saturdays only.

When requesting resources, keep in mind that funding is extremely limited. **Please only order a dumpster if you will fill it at least halfway.** A 40 yard dumpster is 8 feet tall, 22 feet long, and filling one is equivalent to filling 14 pickup trucks full of trash.

Communication is key! If you need to move your cleanup to a different day or didn't fill your dumpster because of inclement weather, call our office and let us know. We're happy to work with you if it means more trash and debris are removed. An empty dumpster is a waste of resources.

#### Who is eligible to receive resources?

Groups and individuals cleaning up <u>vacant</u> and <u>neglected</u> properties on one or more blocks in their neighborhood are eligible.

#### How will resources be distributed?

- Resources are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Groups and individuals must complete and submit the resource request form either online or on the other side of this sheet.
- City staff will continuously accept requests on a rolling basis until resources are no longer available.
