As you know, we suspended temporarily yard-waste and composting services to assess risks to the public and our valued employees. We are happy to announce Republic Services on **Monday, April 27<sup>th</sup>**, will resume collection of yard-waste and compost.

For safe and efficient service, please follow these instructions:

- Place lawn clippings and leaves in a biodegradable paper Kraft bag.
- Use a can – not larger than 35-gallons and clearly marked YARD WASTE – for loose yard waste.
- Ensure all bags and cans weigh less than 50 pounds and do not contain rocks, dirt or sod.

As a reminder, ALL trash and compost must be curbside no later than 6 a.m. on your regularly scheduled collection day. Again, **THANK YOU** for your understanding and partnership during these challenging days.
